Location — Online.

- Jury will assess the submissions on **2 - 15 March**
- Results will be published on **17 March** on Competition website:

- Awards will be sent to winners within 2 weeks after the competition.

5 nominations in one round:

- Solo performance;
- Student ensemble (**can include other instruments**);
- Teacher-Student Ensemble (**can include other instruments**);
- Orchestra (10 or more musicians). The number of **supporting professional musicians** should not be greater than 20% of the total number of musician;
- concertmasters.

Each nomination* has 7 age groups:

- Group A – 9 years old and younger
- Group B – 10-12 years old
- Group C – 13-15 years old
- Group D – 16-18 years old**
- Group E – students of vocational music schools and colleges
- Group F – university/academy-level students
- Group G - no age limit
- Group H - Teachers

*(Age group in Ensemble nomination is determined by the age of the oldest member)

** (Students of vocational music schools and colleges are not allowed to enter this category)

Repertoire and Recording Requirements

- Soloists and ensembles in all categories should perform a maximum of 3 pieces of different styles with the total length of 15 minutes max
- Reading from sheet music is allowed
- Videos should be uploaded by competitors to **Youtube**
- The performed pieces shall be recorded in one file without any recording pauses or stops and without any video or audio editing. Subject to exceptional organizers' approval, it may be possible to submit a video with pauses, but shot during one concert
- Any additional sound or video editing is **not allowed**

- The **performer's hands, instrument and face** should remain in the video frame throughout the entire recording duration
- A link to the recording should be attached to your application (Application Form can be filled at our website music-competition.ru)

Additional requirements for **Composition** nomination

- Winning pieces will be published in Grand Music Art Electronic Collection Volume if agreed by the composer.
 - Composition nomination is split in 2 subnominations:
 1. Original composition
 2. Arrangement:
 - Submissions can be written in any style or genre and for any number of musicians (solo, duo, ensemble, orchestra, choir, etc.)
 - Competitors should provide their submissions in a file created in a notation software (Sibelius, Finale, etc.) or in PDF, JPG or another similar format and in an **audio/video** format (mp3, midi, **youtube** link).
- Competitors may submit **one** piece under each nomination. It is possible to enter both Original Composition and Arrangement nominations at the same time (covered by one entrance fee).

Additional requirements for **Music Studies** nomination

The key requirements for the submitted articles is that they must be original and should not be published earlier.

Terms and conditions

The competition is open for individually and collectively written papers. Papers may be authored by school students, bachelor or master students, post-graduates, as well as by scholars and teachers/professors.

Submissions should be in Russian, have scientific value, contain new insights, be theoretically and practically useful, and have clearly stated and achieved objectives.

The recommended paper size is **15 thousand characters maximum** (with spaces).

Prizes

Diplomas and certificates

- IV and V prize winners will be awarded diplomas
- **All other competitors will receive Certificates of Participation**

Teachers

- Teachers of all I-V prize winners will receive **Certificates of Appreciation.**
- Accompanists of prize winners will also be awarded **Certificates of Appreciation.**

Miscellaneous

- Grand Prix and I Prize cannot be shared/split.
- Jury members may decide not to award certain prizes.
- Jury decisions are final and cannot be changed.

Solo

All age categories – EUR 25

Ensembles

All age categories (up to 3 people) – EUR 25

Above 3 people – **plus** RUB 500 for each ensemble member.

Orchestra/choir (**10+ people**) – EUR 60

Composition, Music Studies

All age categories – EUR 17
